

Position Announcement - Middle Grades Education Faculty

The Department of Education and Teacher Preparation at the College of Coastal Georgia is seeking applicants for a full-time tenure-track appointment at the assistant or associate professor level beginning August 2010. Responsibilities include teaching, advising students, and assisting with the ongoing innovative development of a dual certification program in early childhood/special education and a middle grades education program. Qualified candidates should demonstrate the ability to effectively teach a variety of undergraduate courses involving social studies and/or language arts/English methods for the middle grades, curriculum development, and instruction and assessment, and classroom management. In addition, ideal candidates should have a record of classroom experience teaching students in the middle grades, particularly in the area of social studies and/or language arts/English. Candidates also should possess leadership abilities and evidence of scholarly potential. Doctorate required; preference given to candidates with demonstrated experience with English as a Second Language.

CCGA is a newly designated state college in the 35-member University System of Georgia. Located on the Atlantic Ocean, the College has campuses in Brunswick and Kingsland, Georgia. Presently, the College employs over 200 faculty and staff and serves 3,000 students in pre-baccalaureate and baccalaureate degree programs.
