



CCGA Presidential Honors Scholarship

The CCGA Presidential Honors Scholarship provides awards up to **\$1,100** for qualified students enrolled in baccalaureate degree programs at the College of Coastal Georgia. Scholarship funds may be used to offset the costs of tuition, fees, living expenses, books and supplies, during the period of enrollment at CCGA. The scholarship is awarded upon acceptance and enrollment and is renewable up to one additional year. Up to six (6) awards may be granted annually.

The initial award provides up to **\$400** per semester, beyond any other financial aid for two semesters in an academic year. A stipend of **\$150** per semester is awarded after each successfully completed semester. Successful completion is defined as completing at least 12 credit hours out of the minimum 15 credit hours required for recipients. Full requirements are listed below:

Enrollment in 15 credit hours or more each semester

Completion of at least 13 credit hours each semester with a minimum 3.0 GPA

Participation as an orientation leader (during the end of the first year and during the entire second year)

(Optional) Serve as an academic mentor with students for a minimum number of hours per week as a paid student assistant during the second year.

To apply, students should complete the College of Coastal Georgia Foundation Scholarship application and attach the following: a one-page essay on their educational goals, documentation of participation in extra-curricular activities, and two letters of recommendation (one from a current teacher and one from a past teacher). November 30th is the deadline to submit applications. Incomplete applications will not be considered. In considering scholarship applications, the College of Coastal Georgia may request additional information of applicants and may request to schedule a personal interview.

Scholarship award notices will be sent no later than February 1st.
