

## **Maude Davis Daniel Memorial Scholarship**

Maude Davis Daniels lived most of her life as a resident of Brunswick and the Golden Isles. Maude was a woman of great courage and unwavering in love for her family and God. As a child of the Depression Era, Maude never had the opportunity to attend college but she believed in education, specifically, in the education of young African American women. Maude delighted in seeing young women thrive and she always had an encouraging word imploring young women to strive for the highest heights. This scholarship is in honor of a woman who lived life to the fullest, who gave of herself unselfishly and who delighted in seeing young people thrive.

This scholarship is awarded to a deserving student who is willing to be an outstanding leader and accomplish their goals. Scholarship award amounts may vary. The award is dispersed equally at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters.

This scholarship is awarded annually to outstanding students with financial need who will be attending College of Coastal Georgia to complete their degree and is renewable up to one additional year. Scholarship applications will be accepted and considered for initial award during fall semesters. Student must make and maintain satisfactory academic progress. The deadline for scholarship applications is November 30 for freshman and March 1 for all other students. Applications received after the deadline will be retained as alternates. Criteria include the following:

- Demonstrate financial need (based on results of a completed FAFSA application)
- Minimum 2.5 high school GPA (freshmen) or
- Minimum 2.5 college GPA (all others)

To apply, students should complete the College of Coastal Georgia Foundation Scholarship Application.
