NOTES

1. All classes meeting on a **Saturday** will have final exams on December 5 at the regularly scheduled class time and room.
2. Each examination period is two hours in length and begins at the time designated at the top of each column above. Final examinations **must** be given at the times indicated. Examinations must be taken with the sections in which the student is enrolled except in cases of extreme hardship and only on recommendation of the instructor and approval by the Dean or Department Chair and only if arranged in advance.
3. Examinations must be given in the rooms in which the classes meet regularly unless a change is arranged in advance through the Office of Academic Affairs by the instructor.
4. The following courses do not have final exam times set in the schedule above: all on-line courses; courses meeting at locations other than the Brunswick campus and the Camden Center; and courses with prefixes CMLT, JOUR, and PHED activity courses. Examinations for these courses will be at a time and place set by the instructor and approved by the appropriate Dean or Department Chair.
