



**The ACCEL Program is for students at eligible high schools who wish to take college level coursework for credit towards both high school and college graduation requirements.**

- Must be following an academically stringent curriculum at an accredited high school.
- Be a high school junior or senior seeking a Georgia high school diploma with a 3.00 GPA or higher.
- Have SAT Critical Reading of 500 and SAT Math of 500 or ACT English of 21 or ACT Math of 21.
- Permission from parent/guardian and high school official.
- Be on track toward completion of high school graduation requirements.
