

Gladdin Endowment Scholarship

The Gladdin Endowment Scholarship provides scholarships for students at the College of Coastal Georgia. This scholarship is awarded in recognition of high achievement and leadership skills. Scholarship award amounts may vary. The award is dispersed equally at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters.

This scholarship is awarded annually to outstanding students with financial need who will be attending College of Coastal Georgia to complete their degree and is renewable up to one additional year. Scholarship applications will be accepted and considered for initial award during fall semesters. The priority deadline for scholarship applications is March 1. Applications received after this date will be retained as alternates. Criteria include the following:

- Recipients must have financial need
- Minimum 2.5 high school GPA (freshmen) or
- Minimum 3.0 college GPA (all other students)

To apply, students should complete the College of Coastal Georgia Foundation Scholarship Application.
