

### **St. Simons Women's Club Scholarship**

The St. Simons Women's Club Scholarship provides funds for students who plan to enroll at the College of Coastal Georgia and is renewable up to one additional year. Scholarship award amounts may vary. The award is dispersed equally at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters.

Scholarship applications will be accepted and considered for initial award during fall semesters. The priority deadline for scholarship applications is March 1. Applications received after this date will be retained as alternates. Criteria include the following:
