

Whorton-Dowley-Boswell Endowment Scholarship

The Whorton- Dowley- Boswell Endowment Scholarship provides scholarships for students from the College of Coastal Georgia who plan to enroll in an academic degree program. The recipient must demonstrate a financial need and enroll in at least ten (10) credit hours to be considered for this scholarship. Scholarship award amounts may vary. The award is dispersed equally at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters.

This scholarship is awarded annually to outstanding students with financial need who will be attending College of Coastal Georgia to complete their degree and is renewable up to one additional year. Scholarship applications will be accepted and considered for initial award during fall semesters. The priority deadline for scholarship applications is March 1. Applications received after this date will be retained as alternates. Criteria include the following:

- Demonstrate financial need (based on the results of a completed FAFSA application)
- Enroll in at least 10 credit hours
- Minimum 2.5 high school GPA (freshmen) or
- Minimum 3.0 college GPA (all other students)

To apply, students should complete the College of Coastal Georgia Foundation Scholarship Application.
