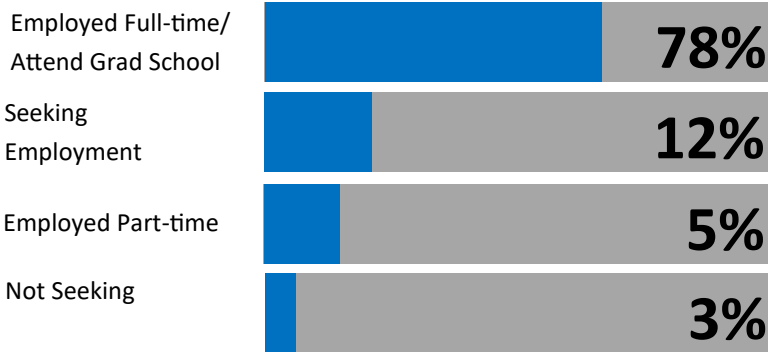


To gauge the success of our programs, CCGA Career Services administers the First Destination Survey to all graduating students. For the 2019 May & December classes, outcome data was obtained from **86.7%** of the 301 graduates.

## EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

93% of graduates reported completing experiential learning (Internships, Externships, Clinicals, Service-Learning) as part of their program of study. **81%** of students participating in experiential learning felt these activities were helpful in preparing for employment.



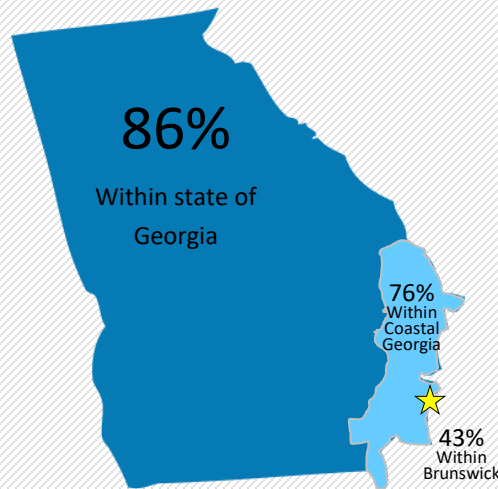
