NOTES

1. All First Session courses will have final exams during their last regular meeting time in their regularly scheduled rooms.
2. Each examination period is two hours in length and begins at the time designated at the top of each column above. Final examinations **must** be given at the times indicated. Examinations must be taken with the sections in which the student is enrolled except in cases of extreme hardship and only on recommendation of the instructor and approval by the Dean and if arranged in advance.
3. Examinations must be given in the rooms in which the classes meet regularly unless a change is arranged in advance by the instructor through the Office of Academic Affairs.
4. The following courses do not have final exam times set in the schedule above: all on-line courses; courses meeting at locations other than the Brunswick campus and the Camden Center; and courses with prefixes JOUR, NURS, RADT and PHED activity courses, support classes, and science labs. Examinations for these courses will be at a time and place set by the instructor and approved by the appropriate Dean.
