



## Glynn County Farm Bureau Student Scholarships

Each year Glynn County Farm Bureau (GCFB) in coordination with the local colleges in Glynn County will award student scholarships. These are a one year scholarship with amounts ranging from \$300 to \$1000. One half of the awarded funds will be paid per the school year semesters. Part-time students, (6 to 11 credit hours), will be eligible for a scholarship up to \$300 each semester.

These funds will be available to pay the cost of books, laboratory fees, field trip assessments, and additional expenses not covered by other scholarships or grants. Students will submit vouchers, invoices, bills, or other debit paper work to the Office Manager of the local GCFB for payment. These payments will not exceed \$500 in total for any one semester. Unused funds in any one semester will revert back to the general scholarship account at GCFB.

Students to be awarded the scholarships will be selected by GCFB. The criteria for selection are: The student must be in good academic standing with a grade point average of at least 3.0 for baccalaureate degree students and a 2.5 GPA for technical career students. A waiver can be granted regarding the 3.0 GPA under review for special circumstances. A one page description of the student's educational goals and how the scholarship will help them attain their goals is also required.
