The College of Coastal Georgia provided a fully executed Memorandum of Understanding describing the details of the arrangement that provides opportunities for its students to complete FinTech courses delivered by the following affiliate institutions: Albany State University, Atlanta Metropolitan State College, Augusta State University, Clayton State University, Columbus State University, Dalton State College, Fort Valley State University, Georgia College and State University, Georgia Gwinnett College, Georgia Highlands College, Georgia Southern University, Georgia Southwestern University, Georgia State University, Gordon State College, Kennesaw State University, Middle Georgia State University, Savannah State University, South Georgia State College, University of Georgia, University of North Georgia, University of West Georgia, and Valdosta State University. Delivery of the courses will be facilitated through services provided by eMajor, the online service provider, a non-Title IV entity. A copy of the signed agreement was provided. 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The institution will offer five 3-credit hour courses (15 credit hours) in financial technology, beginning Fall 2020. These courses will be available as elective courses in the Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.) degree program and the Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree program in Data Science. The courses will comprise less than 25% of each degree program and will be delivered through online instruction by faculty members of affiliate institutions. The College of Coastal Georgia will award the credit for courses taken by its students through this agreement.

Keep in mind that the institution has an obligation to notify SACSCOC prior to the implementation of an agreement with an entity (or entities) not certified to participate in U.S. Department of Education Title IV programs to deliver less than 25% of a program's content recorded on the SACSCOC institution's transcript as its own.
