Thank you for your letter of June 9, 2014, notifying the Commission of the College's agreement with the Department of Homeland Security to award college credit to graduates of three basic training programs offered at the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC):

Criminal Investigator Training Program
Land Management Police Training Program
Uniformed Police Training Program

The College will assign a Criminal Justice Instructor of Record to each of the programs during the course of instruction.
