

Coastal squads earn tennis sweep

The College of Coastal Georgia men's and women's tennis teams swept Southern States Athletic Conference foe Emmanuel College 9-0 on Saturday at Coastal's tennis courts.

The 15th-ranked Mariner women picked up 6-0, 6-0 victories in singles from Priti Rijal, Sunshine Beba and Luisa Lopes, Elektra Hunter, Kristina Polakovic and

Nicole Faas had tougher challenges but still won in straight sets.

In doubles, the teams of Rijal and Faas, Hunter and Polakovic and Beba and Lopes earned victories.

"My focus lately has been on attacking at the net early in doubles and being more aggressive in singles," Rijal said. "I have taken this season one point at a time, really worked on my consistency
