
#### **BLACK HISTORY MONTH**

#### **COLLEGE OF COASTAL GEORGIA'S QUALITY ENHANCEMENT PLAN**

Coastal Georgia is currently undergoing the reaffirmation of accreditation process that happens every 10 years. A key component of this process is the creation of a Quality Enhancement Plant (QEP) that focuses on implementing an initiative that enhances student learning and student success. The previous QEP topic was service-learning, and it is evident how much the service-learning program has become ingrained within our campus culture and reputation in the region.

During the spring and summer of 2020, faculty, staff, students, and administrators worked together to select the QEP topic, COMPASS: Integrated Career and Academic Planning. The QEP Development was then charged with developing this initiative further that will help students succeed by aligning their academic goals with a career path. Students will have an improved understanding of connecting academic courses to career goals for a clear pathway to graduation. The Development Committee is now working on strategies to implement this program with a campus-wide approach that goes beyond the classroom.
