TIPS FOR MAINTAINING YOUR FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY

To keep your financial aid at Coastal Georgia, you need to meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards. SAP makes sure you're moving toward your degree on time. We review your progress at the end of every semester. Here are some tips to help you stay on track and avoid SAP issues:

COMPLETE 67% OF ATTEMPTED HOURS

Ensure you complete at least 67% of all coursework attempted.
Withdrawing or failing classes can negatively affect your completion rate.

MAINTAIN A CUMULATIVE GPA OF 2.0 OR HIGHER

Your Financial Aid GPA must stay at or above 2.0. Some programs, such as Nursing, Radiologic Science, and Education may have higher GPA requirements. Stay informed about your program's standards.

STAY WITHIN THE MAXIMUM TIME FRAME

Complete your degree within 150% of the credit hours required for your program. For example, if your degree requires 120 credit hours, you must finish within 180 credit hours attempted.

Helpful Tips to Stay on Track:

Meet with an Academic Advisor Regularly: They can help you select appropriate courses and stay on schedule.

Monitor Your Progress: Use the college's tools and contact your financial aid counselor to track your Financial Aid GPA, credit hours, and completion rate.

Seek Academic Support: Utilize campus tutoring centers, study groups, and meet with your professor if you're struggling in any classes.

Plan Ahead: Only enroll in courses you're ready to complete and avoid withdrawing from classes unless absolutely necessary.

By staying informed and proactive, you can successfully maintain SAP standards, keep your financial aid, and achieve your academic goals!

What You Need to Know About the Pell Recalculation Date (PRD)

1.What is the Pell Recalculation Date?

This is the date when the Financial Aid Office reviews your enrollment status (how many credit hours you are currently taking) and adjusts your Federal Pell Grant award, if necessary.

2. Why Does It Matter?

Your Pell Grant amount is tied to your enrollment status. If your enrollment status changes after the semester starts (e.g., you drop or add classes), your award may be recalculated to match your current status as of the recalculation date.

What Should You Do?

Lock in Your Schedule: Before the recalculation date, make sure your class schedule reflects your enrollment intentions. Avoid making changes that could reduce your credit hours.

Understand the Impact of Classes: Dropping or Withdrawing courses can reduce your Pell Grant amount, and you may have to repay funds if you've already received a higher award.

Stay Informed: Meet with your financial aid counselor before you drop or withdraw from a course to understand the impact of your award.
