SAP helps ensure you're on track to
finish your degree on time.

- ✓ Complete at least 67% of your classes Dropping or failing classes can hurt your completion rate—so finish strong!
- Keep your GPA at 2.0 or higher Some programs (like Nursing or Education) may require more, so know your program's rules.
- Graduate within 150% of your program's credit hours
 Example: If your degree needs 120 credits, finish within 180 attempted credits.

Meet with your Academic Advisor regularly —they'll help you plan smart.

Monitor your progress using college tools and check in with Financial Aid.

Plan ahead—only take classes you're ready to complete. Avoid unnecessary withdrawals.

Countdown to Graduation: Seniors, Don't Miss These Steps!

Graduation is almost here—congratulations! Before you walk across the stage, make sure you've completed these important financial aid tasks:

Exit Counseling

If you've received federal student loans, you must complete exit counseling. It explains repayment options and helps you plan for life after college. http://studentaid.gov

- ✓ Update Your Contact Information Ensure your email, phone, and address are current so loan servicers can reach you.
- ✓ Know Your Loan Details Log in to studentaid.gov to review your loan balance and servicer information.
- ✓ Plan for Repayment Explore income-driven repayment plans, consolidation options, and forgiveness programs.

Tip: The sooner you understand your repayment options, the easier the transition will be!
